## MESSAGE BY THE PRESIDENT

In 2022, our Organisation set ambitious goals, and steadily moved toward their realisation. We have set targets consisent with our values set out from our conception as well as with our Organisation's Strategy and its four main pillars, namely A) Evidence Based Learning & Information B) Setting up a Legal & Structural framework, C) Aware Healthcare Professionals (HPs) and Empowered Parents, and D) Visibility.

With invaluable allies on our side, such as the Cyprus University of Technology, the Cyprus Federation of Patients' Associations (CyFPA) and other important institutions in Cyprus and internationally, we have succeeded in securing funding for projects to work on the above.

In ongoing Baby Buddy Communicators (BBC) programme we are training HPs in empathy and skills for respectful communication. We have also secured funding for the RESPECT project, which will commence the advocacy part in 2024, aspiring to bring parents and HPs together to develop a framework for Respectful Maternity Care. By securing these projects, we have also secured capacity to employ staff, a pivotal step for our organisational development and operations. At the same time, we have been increasingly and systematically advocating for our positions at the political level, holding meetings with almost all political parties in the country. We have secured our presense and voice in decision making processes, by representing CyFPA, as an example, in the Ad Hoc Commitee and the working group of the National Strategy for the Promotion of Natural Childbirth and the Reduction of Prematurity.

The above is owed largely to our Organisation's culture of cooperation, mutual respect and trust. We feel and support each other as a family, which enables us to act in solidarity, and create and strengthen alliances with other NGOs and partners with whom we share common visions and values. I look forward to seeing the organisation evolve in the direction we have set over the coming years!

# **OUR PROFILE**

We are a member-based, grassroots organization, active throughout Cyprus, islandwide, since 2015.

We are governed by the Annual General Assembly and a Board of 7 members, who are mostly parents themselves, mainly women, We have a Scientific Advisory Board of various professionals (medical, legal, human rights experts) who further our BF vision, and ensure quality and evidence-based nature of its work. # OUR VISION

Our vision at Birth Forward (BF) - Cyprus is for everyone to have the right to evidence based information and education in relation to the creation of a family.

BF empowers and supports mothers, fathers and professionals in making autonomous decisions with a conscious use of technology while, at the same time, respecting the natural process of conception, pregnancy, birth and beyond.



#### **PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES**

In 2022, we secured funding and launched the project "Baby Buddy Communicators", funded by Erasmus+ Small Scale Grants on the Vocational Education and Training (VET) category. This project will design a socially interactive digital environment where practicing and intraining health professionals can receive training to enhance their skills and competencies needed to deliver respectful consultations. BF is the Coordinator for this project, in partnership with Cyprus University of Technology, Ghostthinker and Charité University (Berlin).

Our proposal submitted to the CERV-Daphne call, "RESPECT - Toward a culture of Respectful Maternity Care (RMC): Enhancing Provider-Client Shared Decision Making and Informed Choice" has been selected for funding and will commence in 2023.

We have secured consultancy services from a Project & Grants Manager who is always on the look for suitable project funding opportunities and engages the team in developing project concepts and proposals in line with our vision and strategies. Our close collaboration with the Cyprus University of Technology Nursing Department, and the valuable input of our Scientic Advisory Board (SAB) are pivotal in these efforts.

# EVENTS & AWARENESS RAISING

We are very active in what is going on in the community, and we make sure to be constantly present in collective NGO and patner events.

In 2022 we participated in large events such as the Annual NGO fair organized by the Youth Board of Cyprus, and the Simultaneous Breastfeeding event organized by the Pancyprian Association for Breastfeeding "Gift for Life",


We have appeared on TV and radio shows to advocate for the implementation of policies that will ensure the safeguarding of human rights in childbirth and the decrease of cesareans.
















#### VISIBILITY

We continue to be very active on Social Media. Understanding its importance as a communication medium, in 2022, we hired a professional communications company, Mikroskopio Marketing, to manage our Social Media and grow our followers and reach.

We constantly reach out to the community with information and educational posts, but also take positions on current developments.

In 2022, we recorded, edited and posted a series of reels by our community members and also professionals, sharing stories, tips, and breaking myths and taboos. We created and shared reels on breastfeeding and returning to work, rights of pregnant women, infertility, IVF, exercise during pregnancy.

We also organized facebook lives on Pregnancy Loss, Infertility and Breastfeeding, and held online islandwide Parenting Talks (open meetings).

We held a joint Online event with child psychologist Belina Louvrou "Connection with baby through play" and with personal development counsellor Andrea Georgiou "Butterfly Circle".

#### **ADVOCACY & LOBBYING**

2022 was an important year for our Advocacy & Lobbying efforts.

With a Political Represenative addition to our team, we organized and held a series of meetings with MPs, political parties, represenatives of the National Insurance Organization (OAY). We strengthened our political presence and influence.

We actively lobbied in the parliament for the extension of Parental Leave. We participated in the relevant meetings in the Commitee of Labour and suggested amendments to the proposed law. We brought the issue of high percentage of cesareans to the Parliament Health Committee.

We represent the Cyprus Federation of Patients Associations (OSAK) in the National Committee on the Promotion of Natural Birth and Reduction of Prematurity,

We also acted upon various matters concerning violations of the human rights of pregnant and birthing people such as bans of birth partners with the excuse of Covid.





#### ACHIEVEMENTS & SUCCESS STORIES

Our work is underlied by our common core values, ethics, caring for the community and each other, and ensuring transparency.

Holding and building the community is a great strength of ours. We work hard getting people together and contributing for a common cause.


Our operation and work follows the targets outlined in our Strategic Plan.

In 2022 Income was generated by Baby Buddy Communicators project (BBC Erasmus+) and Membership fees.

Expenses concerned auditors and accounting fees, expences incurred by the BBC project, project management fees, meeting expenses, social media and website expenses, and other.

For 2023, we have also secured project funding through CERV-Daphne for the upcoming project "Respect: Toward a culture of Respectful Maternity Care (RMC)". Our organisation is partner in the Consortium.

We expect to continue to secure income through regular and professional membership fees, but also plan to look into additional project funding opportunity, as well as private donors- through CSR programs.
